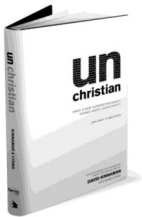
Living the Christian Life *Greg Pritchard*

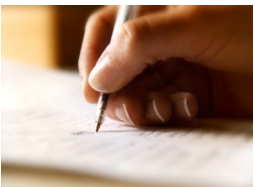
Sonship *Nate Conrad and Art Wittmann*
