(Actor or Actress will learn the Caesar Announcer Aide part. This part must be memorized. Someone will read the other lines for cues.)

Caesar's Announcer: I can't just start with the bad news.

Caesar Announcer Aide: They knew it was bad news when we showed up.

Caesar's Announcer: Seriously, just go out and tell a couple of jokes. You can do it.

Caesar Announcer Aide: (walks down to mic) Hello everybody.

(Crowd interrupts with loud dismay.)

Caesar Announcer Aide: Yeah, well, I have a joke for you. What do you call a cow that just had a calf?

(Crowd is suddenly quiet.)

Caesar Announcer Aide: Decaffeinated. (Announcer and Aide laugh and drummer provides punctuation.)

Aaron: Just get on with it. Don't offend us with stupid jokes.

Caesar Announcer Aide: (to Announcer) Yeah, just get it over with, and be prepared to run! Let's get out of here!
